re: Monaco Residents Permit

Thank you for your letter of 13th October. I am pleased to confirm that you are entitled to the arms *Argent a Chevron between three Cross crosslets fitchy Sable* as illustrated on the shield at the head of your writing paper. This coat of arms was registered as his paternal arms for your ancestor Henry Davenport of Hollon in Shropshire on 3 September 1664 at Bridgnorth during the Herald's Visitation of Shropshire (College of Arms Ms: C35/90). Henry Davenport was then aged 57.

The College of Arms Examiners have accepted your descent from Henry Davenport and thus your entitlement to the coat of arms. The descent is as follows:- Henry Davenport was the father of Henry Davenport aged 20 in 1664 who died in 1698, the father of Henry Davenport (died 1731) the father of Sharrington Davenport (died 1774) the father of Edward Davenport (died 1812) the father of Edmund Sherrington Davenport (died 1842) the father of William Sharrington Davenport (died 1871) the father of Charles Talbot Davenport (died 1919) the father of Talbot Neville Fawsett Davenport who predeceased his father and died 1905, the father of your father Ormus Neville Talbot Davenport.
